2016 - 2017 School Board Goals & Expectations

1. **ACHIEVEMENT:** Prioritize student achievement and provide high quality instruction in every classroom, every day.

- A. 85% of K-12 grade students on grade level in literacy and math.
- B. 85% of 5th and 8th grade students meeting proficiency in science.
- C. 95% of 6-12 grade students earning “C” or above in core academic classes.
- D. 95% of grade 9 students earning sufficient credit.
- E. 85% of grade 10 students proficient on end of course exam 1 or 2 in math.
- F. 85% of grade 10 students proficient on end of course exam in biology.
- G. 100% of grade 12 students successfully meeting graduation requirement.
- H. Increase by 10% the number of students taking and passing a college level course by 12th grade.

2. **EQUITY:** Provide equity, access, and opportunity to all students and families in a student-focused learning organization.

- A. Increase by 10% the number of low income students enrolled in Honors and AP courses grades 7-12.
- B. 100% of eligible 8th grade students enrolled in the College Bound Scholarship Program.
- C. Increase by 10% the number of ELL students enrolled in Honors and AP courses 7-12.
- D. Increasing the percentage of ELL students exiting ELL within 5 years.
- E. 70% of 12th grade students completing the FAFSA.
- F. Decrease the number of students suspended in grades 7-12.
- G. Increase district-wide student attendance rates.

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3. **STEWARDSHIP:** Ensure responsible allocation of resources to maximize student learning.

- A. Sustain the undesignated fund balance at 4%-5%.
- B. Retire LGO (limited general obligation) bond debt.
- C. Continue upgrading district facilities.
- D. Improve efficiencies in transportation, food service and custodial services.
- E. Continue the implementation of the district-wide Technology and Safety Plan supported by funds approved through the Technology and Safety Levy.

4. **PARTNERSHIPS:** Develop and sustain strong partnerships with our community in order to create a more unified learning environment for everyone.

- A. Increase family engagement opportunities in all schools.
- B. Provide opportunities for citizen participation and input.
- C. Increase community partnerships in support of all schools.

5. **CONTINUOUS LEARNING:** Foster a community of life-long learners.

- A. Develop an awareness of the benefits for life-long learning throughout the school community.
- B. Develop and emphasize critical thinking, problem solving, communication and collaboration skills for all students.
