

COVID-19 Screening Flowchart

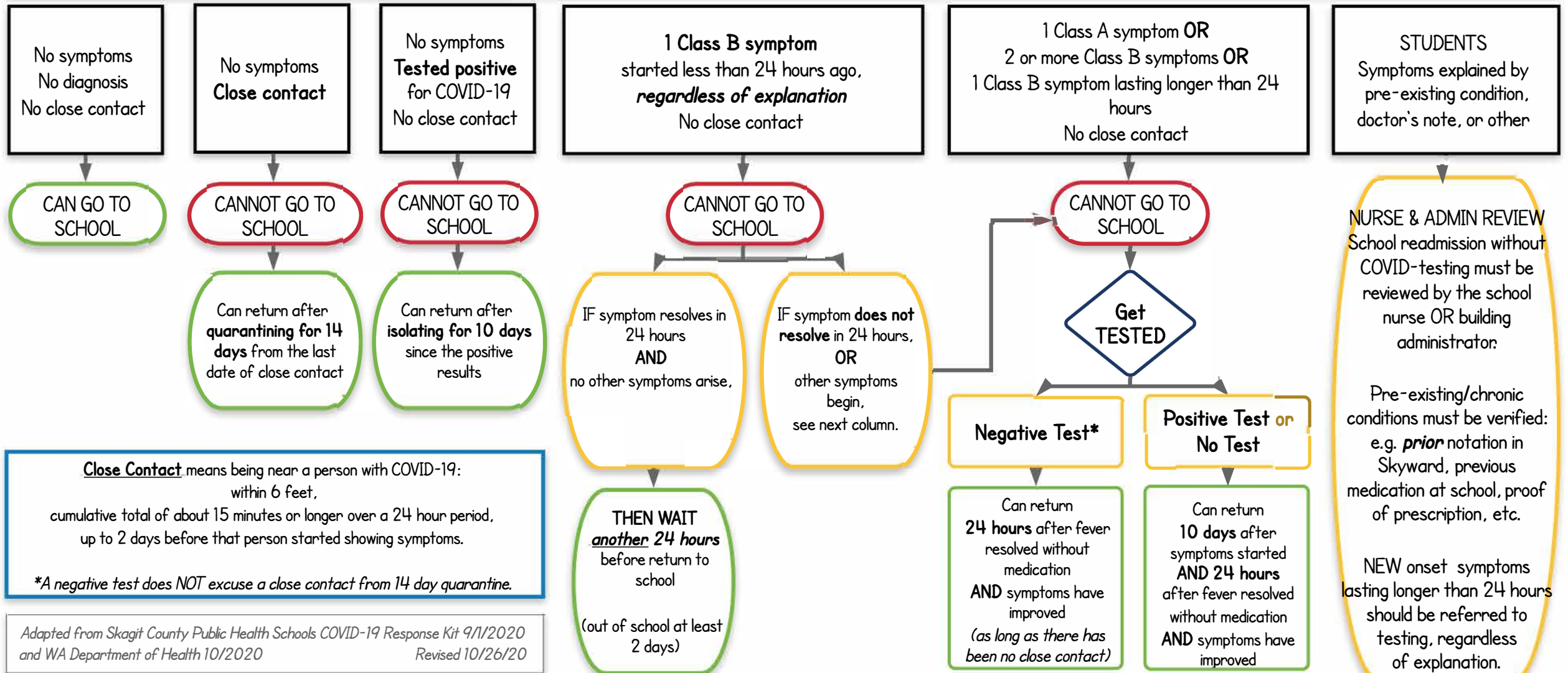
This guidance will be used by the SWSD when the COVID-19 rate in the community is MODERATE-HIGH:

Class A Symptoms

- Fever (defined as subjective or 100.4F or higher)
- Chills, Cough
- Loss of sense of taste and/or smell
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Class B Symptoms

- Fatigue
- Headache
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Congested or runny nose
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea (defined as 2 or more loose stools in 24 hours)
- Other signs of a new, unexplained illness, unrelated to a preexisting condition (e.g. seasonal allergies)



Close Contact means being near a person with COVID-19: within 6 feet, cumulative total of about 15 minutes or longer over a 24 hour period, up to 2 days before that person started showing symptoms.

*A negative test does NOT excuse a close contact from 14 day quarantine.
