  - D. 70% of 12<sup>th</sup> grade students completing the FAFSA.
  - E. Decrease the number of students suspended in grades 7-12.
  - F. Increase district-wide student attendance rates by reducing chronic absence.

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- 3. STEWARDSHIP: Ensure responsible allocation of resources to maximize student learning.
  - A. Sustain the undesignated fund balance at 3%-5%.
  - B. Continue upgrading district facilities.
  - C. Improve efficiencies in transportation, food service and custodial services.
  - D. Continue the implementation of the district-wide Technology and Safety Plan supported by funds approved through the Technology and Safety Levy.
