THE WA STATE LEGISLATIVE YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL (LYAC) IS NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2019-2021 CYCLE! Each year, 11 new students are selected for a 2 year commitment to serve on the Council, during which time they dive into the legislative process with mentors who advise them on effectively advocating for meaningful policy changes. To be eligible for the program, applicants must be from 14 to 18 years of age and be in 8th, 9th, or 10th grade. Applicants are also required to submit one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach, mentor, or community leader. Applications and letters of recommendation are due by **6/3/2019**.
