The Sedro-Woolley School District Board of Directors met for a regular meeting on January 28, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at Cascade Middle School. Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Phil Brockman stated that in response to the measles outbreak in southwest Washington, district nursing staff are proactively reviewing staff and student immunizations records. Mr. Brockman noted the annual Community Recognition Program is seeking nominations and that the recognition ceremony will be held on April 18. Superintendent Brockman then stated Director Enrique López Cisneros and he will be attending the WSSDA Equity Conference on May 26. Next, Mr. Brockman commented on the Logging Rodeo Team winning the state championship for the 19th time, recent debate team competition results, the state music competition and the recent collaborative event with Habit For Humanity and the high school's CTE programs. In closing, Superintendent Brockman noted that recent school district Facebook posts recognizing School Board Appreciation Month received numerous positive comments.

Student Board Representative Lexie Rodriguez-Padilla provided an activity report and acknowledged donations made to the district.


Financial Report
