### Welcome 2023/2024 Kindergarten students!

The Sedro-Woolley School District Food Service Department operates the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). Participation in CEP allows the district to offer one free breakfast and one free lunch to all students attending school within the district.

With meals being served free of charge to all students, families no longer need to complete a Free/Reduced-price Meal Application to receive meals free of charge. However, families who qualified for F/R benefits in the past or believe they would qualify are encouraged to complete a Family Income Survey. If your family income meets a specific threshold as outlined on the Family Income Survey, your students may be eligible for waived sports fees, class and testing fees, etc. Submitting the Family Income Survey also helps ensure school funding is maintained for essential programs throughout the district.

If you currently have students enrolled in the district who qualify for reduced fees through the Family Income Survey, please note that your new Kindergartener will *not* automatically receive benefits without a new **2023-24** Family Income Survey. To ensure your Kindergartener is receiving the associated benefits when school begins, the 2023-24 Family Income Survey should be completed prior to the first day of school. Only one survey is needed per household, and should include all of your eligible students for the new school year. **\*Please note:** We cannot accept a **2022-23** Family Income Survey and apply it to next school year per USDA rules. The Family Income Survey for next school year will be available in August 2023.

### **Food Service Program Information**

The Sedro-Woolley School District participates in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs. Therefore, all meals offered and served must meet USDA guidelines:

- A reimbursable breakfast consists of at least three items from the following food categories. Please note that student must select a ½ cup of fruit with their breakfast meal.  
\*Whole Grains \*Fruit \*Milk
- A reimbursable lunch consists of at least three components from the following food categories. Please note that students must select a ½ cup of fruit and/or vegetable with their lunch meal.  
\*Whole Grains \*Meat/Meat Alternate \*Fruit \*Vegetables \*Milk

Students receive meal pricing based upon the following meal benefit categories: **free, reduced price, and paid.** The associated costs are provided below:
